A few words on the **87th ACFAS congress** at UQO. The General director of CDC Pontiac participated in 3 conferences and shares some thoughts:

Les innovations sociales face au changement politique. (Social innovations in the context of political change). Innovations multiply, but institutions sometimes move slowly. It is necessary to persevere, to create spaces of dialogue and to make known more the social economy, among others with the municipal sector. The social economy is well established in Quebec and is an important alternative in economic development. To go further: Consult the website of the **Pôle d'économie sociale** and **TISS**.

La municipalisation du développement social au Québec. (The municipalization of social development in Quebec.) How to support social development initiatives in a context in which municipal sectors have more and more responsibilities but not the funding that goes with it. The reforms of 2014-2015 (Centralization at the CISSSO, closure of the CRÉO, etc.) have had significant effects in terms of social development and led to a necessary restructuring of governance. Without taking for granted that they have the responsibility for social development in their territories, municipal elected officials should accept shared leadership in this area. Elected, organizations, youth and citizens: we all need to work together.

Vieillesse, autonomie et interdépendance: une contradiction ? (Aging, autonomy and interdependence: a contradiction?) Counter ageism and get rid of stereotypes related to aging. We understand quite correctly aging in our societies. Promote autonomy and home care by supporting preventive approaches and reconciling decision-making autonomy (independence) and relational autonomy (interdependence). Promoting health is not only a matter of state: it could also go through citizen initiatives. We need to work on aspects that improve the quality of individual life and those that improve our environments. In this sense, the Québec model, **Municipalités amies des aînés (MADA)** (Age-Friendly Municipalities) is cited as an example. In Canada, more than 800 of the approximately 1,200 age-friendly municipalities are located in Québec.
